Ark Encounter








Day 4:

Queen.





A visit to Amelia Island is not complete without a tour of the scenic waterways. Enjoy a two-hour narrated, historic and wildlife sightseeing tour with views of dolphins, manatees, sea otters, alligators and frequent sightings of the wild horses of Cumberland Island National Seashore

Day 4:

- Breakfast at hotel
- Guided Tour of Fort Clinch

Step back in time to the 1860's as you tour historic Fort Clinch. The entrance to the Cumberland Sound and the St. Mary's River has been of vital importance to the people of Florida for close to 300 years. The first fortifications on the site began in 1736. As the Union started to gain control of coastal and southern Georgia, General Robert E. Lee gave the order to evacuate, and Union troops arrived here in March of 1862. Work on the fort commenced, but it was still not completed by the end of the Civil War. Fort Clinch became one of Florida's first state parks in 1935.



Day 4 (continued):

- Lunch & free time on own in Amelia Island
- Guided sightseeing tour of American Beach

Our touring continues from the downtown Historic District to American Beach. It was founded in 1935 by Florida's first black millionaire, Abraham Lincoln Lewis, as a beach retreat for African-Americans during the time of segregated beaches. Hear about the "Beach Lady," Lewis' great-granddaughter, and the decades she spent preserving the heritage and history of American Beach. Here you will also see the tallest sand dune in Florida.

- Travel to Jacksonville, FL
- Visit Kingsley Plantation
- Return to hotel to freshen up
- Enjoy Dinner at a Local Restaurant

- Travel home






